3. After considering the eligibility and ranking criteria in detail, the Vice Chancellor in exercise of the powers vested with the Academic Council, has approved the eligibility and criteria for ranking applicable for UG Programmes as recommended by the Board of Studies concerned.
4. Orders are therefore issued by the Vice Chancellor to implement the eligibility and ranking criteria for UG Programmes with effect from 2014 admission as appended.



**DEGREE COURSES : Eligibility and Criteria for Ranking**

(w.e.f 2014 admission)

Candidates who have passed Plus two/Higher Secondary or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University only are eligible for admission to UG courses under various faculties (Languages and Literature, Humanities, Social Science, Management Studies and Science) as specified below.

**A. Under the Faculty of Languages and Literature**

1. **BA (Malayalam)**
2. **BA (Hindi)**
3. **BA (Functional Hindi)**
4. **BA ( Arabic)**
5. **BA (Sanskrit)**
6. **BA ( Kannada)**

A(i) Applicants be ranked on the basis of the total marks plus twice the marks secured in the additional languages concerned of Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University.

A(ii) A weightage of 20 marks be given to those who have studied the language concerned as optional at the above mentioned qualifying examinations.



A(iii) Provided in the case of BA (Sanskrit) candidates with the following qualifications are also eligible for admission.

(a) A pass in the SSLC with Sanskrit and a pass in the Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University.

(b) In the absence of the candidates with above qualifications mentioned at para.A(i),A(ii) and A(iii)(a) those candidates who have passed Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University may also be considered for admission on the basis of merit and aptitude test.

A(iv) Provided that in the absence of candidates with qualifications mentioned at para.A(i),and A(ii) , those candidates who possess the following qualification may also be considered for admission to BA (Kannada) course.

(a) Candidates who passed Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Govt. of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University with Sanskrit/Hindi or language subjects and having Kannada as mothertounge

**7. BA (Englsh)**

**8. BA (Functional English)**

Applicants will be ranked on the basis of total marks plus twice the marks secured in English of Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University.

In the case of BA Englsh, A weightage of twenty marks will be given to those who have studied English as optional subject for Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kannur University.

In the case of BA Functional English , Plus two or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 20 marks for those who studied Communicative English/Functional English/Journalism/Media Studies and English Literature at +2 level.

**9. BA (Afzal-UI-Ulama)**

Pass in Afzal –UI –Ulama Preliminary/Plus two examinations recognised by Kannur University.

**B. Under the Faculty of Humanities**

1.	<b>BA (History)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of Fifty marks for the subject History studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.
2. 3.	<b>BA (Economics)</b> <b>BA (Development Economics)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 25% marks for the subject Economics studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.  Admission is also open to Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination with Mathematics or Statistics provided the total number of such candidate admitted do not exceed 25% of total strength. However these students are not eligible for weightage of marks.

4.	<b>BA (Philosophy)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 50 marks for the subjects Logic/Psychology studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination
5.	<b>BA (Urdu and Islamic History)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 50 marks for the subjects Urdu/Islamic History studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.
6.	<b>BA(Arabic and Islamic History)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 50 marks for the subjects Arabic /Islamic History studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.
7.	<b>BA (Anthropology)</b>	Plus Two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University
8.	<b>BA Music (Karnatic)</b>	Plus two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by the University. Ranking will be done on the basis of marks in the qualifying examination plus marks obtained in the aptitude test in music.
9.	<b>BA Bharathanatyam</b>	Plus two or Higher Secondary Examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination

		recognised by the University. Ranking will be done on the basis of marks in the qualifying examination plus marks obtained in the aptitude test in dance.

**C. Under the Faculty of Social Sciences**

1.	<b>BA (Political Science)</b>	Candidates may be ranked on the basis of the marks secured at Plus Two or Higher Secondary examination of Government of Kerala or equivalent examination recognised by Kanur University and a weightage of 50 marks be given to those candidates who have studied the subject Political Science/Civics at the qualifying examination.
2.	<b>BA (Sociology)</b>	Plus Two or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 50 marks for the subject of Sociology studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination or weightage of 25 marks for the subject of Humanities studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.
3.	<b>BSW</b>	Plus Two or equivalent examination recognised by the University plus a weightage of 25% for the subject of social work studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination.

## **D. Under the Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies**

### **1. B.Com:**

Plus two or equivalent examination recognised by the University. Candidates who have not taken at least one commerce subject for Plus two/equivalent examination should get at least 45% of the aggregate marks in the /Plus two/equivalent examinations. A weightage of 25 marks for each commerce subjects such as Accounting, Business studies, Management Studies, Auditing, Computer Application, Banking, Income tax and Economics taken by the candidate is to be given to Plus two marks subject to a maximum of 75 marks.

### **2. Bachelor of Travel and Tourism Management (BTTM)**

Plus 2/equivalent exams with 50%marks. A weightage of 25 marks for each subject such as Management, Economics, History and Geography studied by the candidate at the qualifying examination. A weightage of 25 marks is also given to those candidates who have passed VHSE/Travel and Tourism/ Catering & Hospital Management. The total of all such weightage should not exceed 75 marks

### **3. BBM**

Should have passed plus 2 or equivalent examination and have secured at least 45% marks in aggregate . A weightage of 25 marks for each Commerce subjects studied by the candidate at he Plus two/equivalent examination

### **4. BBA/BBA (TTM)**

Admission shall be made from the candidates who have passed the Plus two or equivalent examination with 45% for non commerce subject ( not applicable to SC/ST students) and pass mark for Commerce subjects. A weightage of 25 marks be given for each Commerce subject studied by the candidate in the qualifying examination subject to a maximum of 75 marks.

21.	<b>B.Sc Geography</b>	Should have passed plus two or equivalent examination	Marks of the qualifying examination + Marks of Geography

### **Calculation of Index Marks :-**

In addition to the existing criteria for calculation of index marks for admission to B.Sc courses, the following rules are also to be complied with:

- a) If two candidates have same index marks, priority must be given to the candidate who secured more marks in the qualifying examination for the subject for which admission is sought
- b) If the two candidates have same index marks even after this, priority must be given to candidate who scored higher marks in compulsory subsidiary subject.
- c) If the rank is still the same, priority should be given to the candidate having higher marks in second subsidiary subject.

**Note:** qualifying examination mentioned under eligibility means Plus Two ,Higher Secondary, V.H.S.C etc. or equivalent examination recognised by the University.

General rules for admission implemented by the University with effect from 2002 and 2004 admissions shall be followed in all other cases relating to admission.

The minimum eligibility for admission, weightage of marks, calculation of index marks etc. will be as prescribed by the respective Board of Studies from time to time.
